Business Resource Groups: Women Leadership Development (WLD)

Following the onset of the pandemic in India, UPS swiftly provided support to the GOI's response by mobilizing resources and facilitating the transportation of critical medical supplies – including oxygen, ventilators, PPE, etc.

The UPS Foundation [provided USD 1 million](#) to fight the COVID-19 surge in India, which was used towards emergency funding, in-kind transportation movements and technical expertise to provide urgent relief.

Since 2011, UPS and The UPS Foundation have partnered with the AIP Foundation in India to raise awareness on road safety and protect children from traffic accidents through a combination of education, public outreach, and policy advocacy.

UPS worked closely with International Trade Centre's SheTrades India initiative. The objective of the initiative is to help increase the participation of women owned businesses in international trade in India and across the world.
