Key Partnerships in 2022



Impacted 145 youth through legal advocacy, trauma-informed case management, group therapy and empowering activities



COR's House of Cherith provides job training and placement for survivors with an 80% success rate for sustained placement



Surpassed 100,000 total UPSers trained to recognize and report the signs of human trafficking alongside six TAT Ambassadors



Greater Atlanta

Provided trauma-informed approaches to over 500 survivors of human trafficking, sexual assault and domestic violence



Impacted 177 women through the Women's Academy, a program that significantly reduces the gap of re-exploitation



Supported 350 survivors by providing job training and safe, stable employment via the Safe Jobs Collaborative

Leadership in Action

UPS provides in-kind labor and support for the Freedom Drivers Project, a mobile 18-wheeler exhibit that educates audiences about the realities of domestic sex trafficking.
